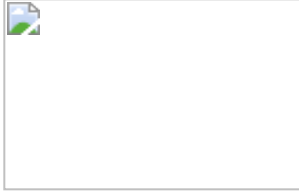
Q: What can manufactured home owners do if their community seems at risk to close for redevelopment?
