FEATURED ARTICLE:

If manufactured homes are so affordable, why are so few being built?

Considering the severe shortage of affordable housing in the United States, why is the annual production of new manufactured homes so low? The cost per square to produce a manufactured home is 35% to 47% less than a site-built home. But still, the number of manufactured homes shipped each year has gone from averaging 242,000 per year between 1977 and 1993, to more than 300,000 per year from 1994 to 1999, to just 92,500 units in 2017.

As a result, production capacity has dramatically shrunk. In 1990, 100 manufactured housing producers operated 250 plants. Today, there are 34 operators and 121 plants in operation.

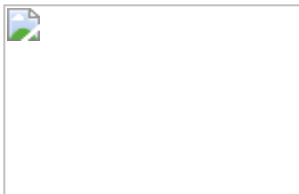
Q: In the spirit of tax season, which is just around the corner, must you file your tax return by April 15 even if you are expecting a refund? Is there a penalty for filing late?

A: While taxpayers **who owe** the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) face numerous penalties for filing their taxes late, there is **NO PENALTY** for those who are owed a refund and file late.

However, the IRS warns taxpayers to file their taxes as soon as possible. Although you won't

be assessed a penalty if you file taxes late and you're owed a refund, you **WILL FORFIT** your refund if you wait more than **THREE YEARS** past the original due date to file your return. If you are filing late, remember you must use the tax forms from the year your tax filing was due. Also, if you file late, it can take up to 45 days to receive a refund from the IRS. After 45 days, if you have still not received your refund, contact the IRS by calling 1-800-829-4477.
