Manufactured Home Owners Lobby Members of Congress

Representatives of NMHOA and the state manufactured home owner associations participated in the [3rd annual Consumer Lobby Day](#) on May 8 in Washington, D.C. The event was spearheaded by the **Consumer Federation of America**, but was also backed by all the best known national consumer groups.

There was a common focus on a strong and independent **Consumer Financial Protection Bureau**, protections against **predatory lending**, and opposition to **forced arbitration** for consumers. We also supported the introduction of two manufactured housing proposals described below: the **HUD Manufactured Housing Modernization Act of 2019**, and the **Frank Adelman Manufactured Housing Community Sustainability Act**.

The representatives also stayed for the [2019 Consumer Assembly](#) on May 9-10. During the assembly, manufactured housing policy recommendations proposed by NMHOA were added to Consumer Federation of America's policy platform.

Proposed Federal to Support Manufactured Home Owners

Representative Norma Torres (D-CA) and **Senator Catherine Cortez Masto** (D-NV) introduced the **HUD Manufactured Housing Modernization Act of 2019** ([H.R. 926](#)). It requires state and local jurisdictions to include manufactured housing in their **Consolidated Plans**. A Consolidated Plan is designed to help state and local governments assess their affordable housing and community development needs. Inclusion in these plans allows projects involving manufactured housing to seek support through federal funding programs, such as **Community Development Block Grant** (CDBG) Program, **HOME Investment Partnerships** (HOME) Program, **Emergency Solutions Grant** (ESG) Program, and **Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS** (HOPWA) Program.

Senator Jeanne Shaheen (D-NH) and **Representative Ilhan Omar** (D-MN) will re-introduce the **Frank Adelman Manufactured Housing Community Sustainability Act** ([S. 1581](#)) to encourage sale of manufactured home communities to residents. The proposal provides a tax incentive for community owners to sell to their residents. It creates a 75% federal tax credit on the sale of the property. For example, if the owner

sells the land to a resident cooperative, instead of paying \$150,000 on a \$1 million gain, the owner will only pay \$37,500. The proposal is being supported by:
