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Ask Dave

Q: Why do people give to nonprofit organizations and how can I persuade people to give to mine?

A: People give for a variety of reasons. However, many non-profits appeal to motives that are not very persuasive: "We need the money" and "Your contribution is tax deductible." Neither reason is special either to your organization or to the potential donor. Giving is highly personal. It is central to understand people's perspectives and above all their self interest.

This system is so large that, if all non-profits did the same work, they would be the nation's largest industry—employing 10 percent of the workforce and generating 5 percent of the Gross Domestic Product. There are over one million organizations recognized as tax-exempt non-profits by the Internal Revenue Service and there are several million more that are small, grass roots organizations with no formal status—including block clubs, community gardens, etc. The obvious question to ask for those seeking it is: Where then does the money come from?
